SOME GOOD PRACTICES

- All officers regularly have face to face meeting with the students to resolve their problems and also to consolidate learner support services.
- Timely and effective communications are made to the students for the changes effected in the support system on account of unavoidable circumstances (closure/shifting of Study Centres, conduct of practical for B.Sc.; computer programmes, distribution of study material).
- Very close coordination with the Hqrs. (particularly RSD, SED, SRD and MPDD) is maintained for resolving student problems.
- Strict adherence to the guidelines/deadlines of the hqrs. is followed in transmission of various data, report etc.
- Timely availability of requisite support (academic, administrative and financial) is ensured to LSCs for strengthening the overall support system.
- The monthly monitoring reports, account statements are submitted on time to the HQs. Financial books and records are maintained up-to-date.
- All the staff members are provided necessary exposure and training in handling the computerized support system for quick redressal of the student support related matters.










JURISDICTIONAL AREA

ABOUT REGIONAL CENTRE

IGNOU Regional Centre Delhi – 3 was notified on 27th October 2008 to provide better services to the students and public residing in West Delhi, South West Delhi and Gurugram & Mewat (Haryana). Initially the Regional Centre was functioning from the premises of Regional Centre Delhi-1. The Regional Centre moved in its own building located at Palam Extension, Near Saheed Ramphal Chowk, Dwarka, New Delhi









110077 in January 2010. There are 50 learner support centers comprising of 14 Regular Study Centres, 4 Special Study Centers, 1 Recognized Study Centre and 29 Programme Study Centres and 2 Jail Study Centres offering a wide range Programmes from Computer Science & IT programmes to Management, Education Health Sciences, Agriculture and Performing Arts etc. The area under this Regional Centre meets the educational needs of 187343 students with excellent student support services network with 50 different learner support centres. This centre is also continuously striving to contribute in catering to the educational requirements of this area.
