List of these A/V programmes and their web links are given in the self learning materials;

· you will submit your assignments on time.

• Apart from the theory counselling being conducted at your respective study centres, it is planned to conduct web (email based) counselling by the Faculty based at Headquarters to give you a way to interact with the course team. The schedule for web counselling is attached. The purpose is the Kindly respond to the counselling sessions and make it interactive. NOTE THAT THIS IS IN ADDITION TO THE COUNSELLING SESSIONS ALREADY PLANNED / TO BE CONDUCTED AT THE STUDY CENTRES.
