- Suitability of the topic
- Relevance of the topic to the CSR &Time available
- Feasibility & Cost involved in data collection
- Challenges involved in data collection & how to meet them?
- Communication facilities & local language etc.

#### **Project Proposal Contents**

- Title
- Introduction
- Objectives
- Problem Statement
- Research Methodology (Locale, Sampling, Instruments & Statistical tools)
- Expected outcome
- Limitations, if any
- References.

#### **Project Work Methodology**

**Project Work vs. Information.** 

More valid is the source of information, the more reliable will be the information received.

Information to be collected depends upon the type of CSR research - wide knowledge of kinds & sources of primary and secondary information.

Various methods are applied for different projects.

#### **Project Report Preparation**

**Length:** 40 to 50 typed pages / 10,000 words (10% variation permissible).

**Sections:** Title, Introduction, Objectives, Problem Statement, Research Methodology (with locale, sampling, instruments and statistical tools used), Results & Discussion, Summary, Limitations & References.

The project report should also contain: Approved project proposal proforma (2<sup>nd</sup> page) & Certificate of originality - signed by student & supervisor (3<sup>rd</sup> page).
